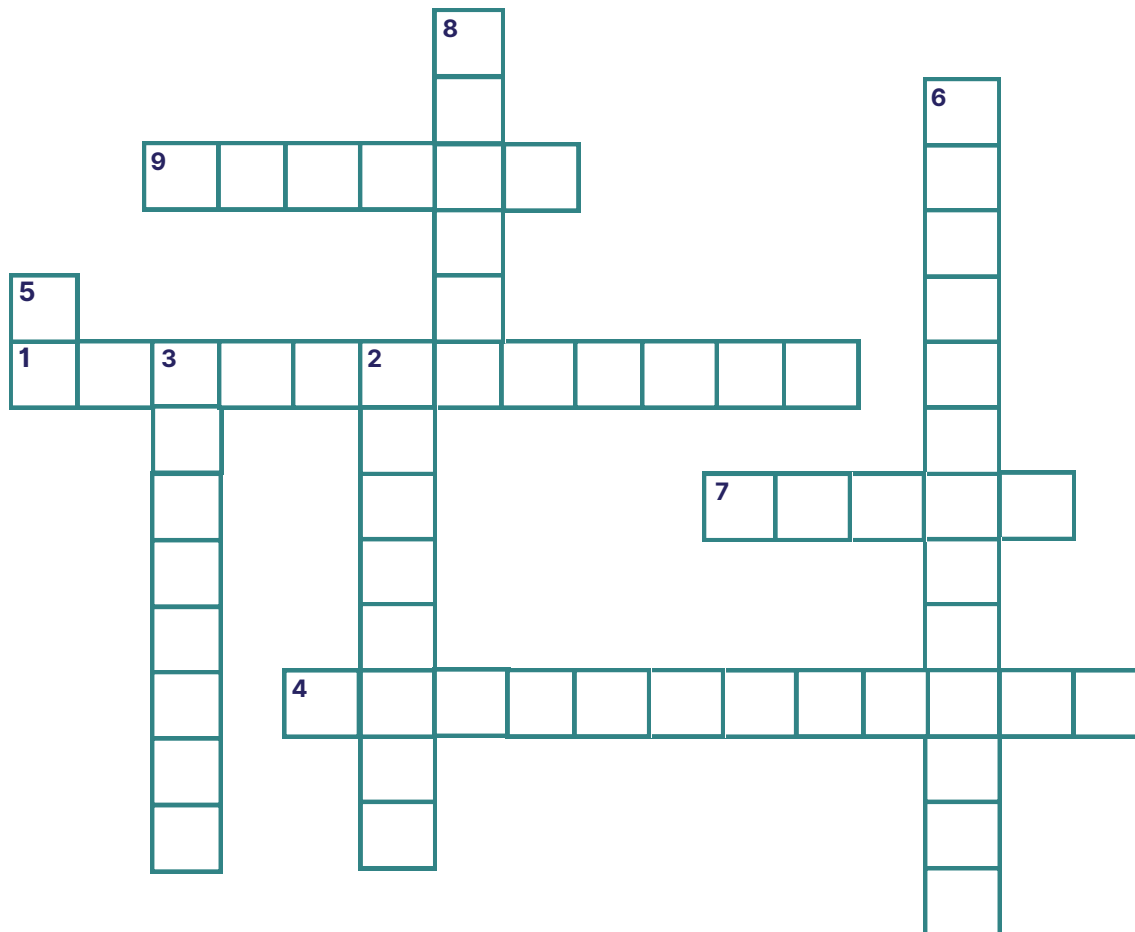




DEEP ZONE



Across:

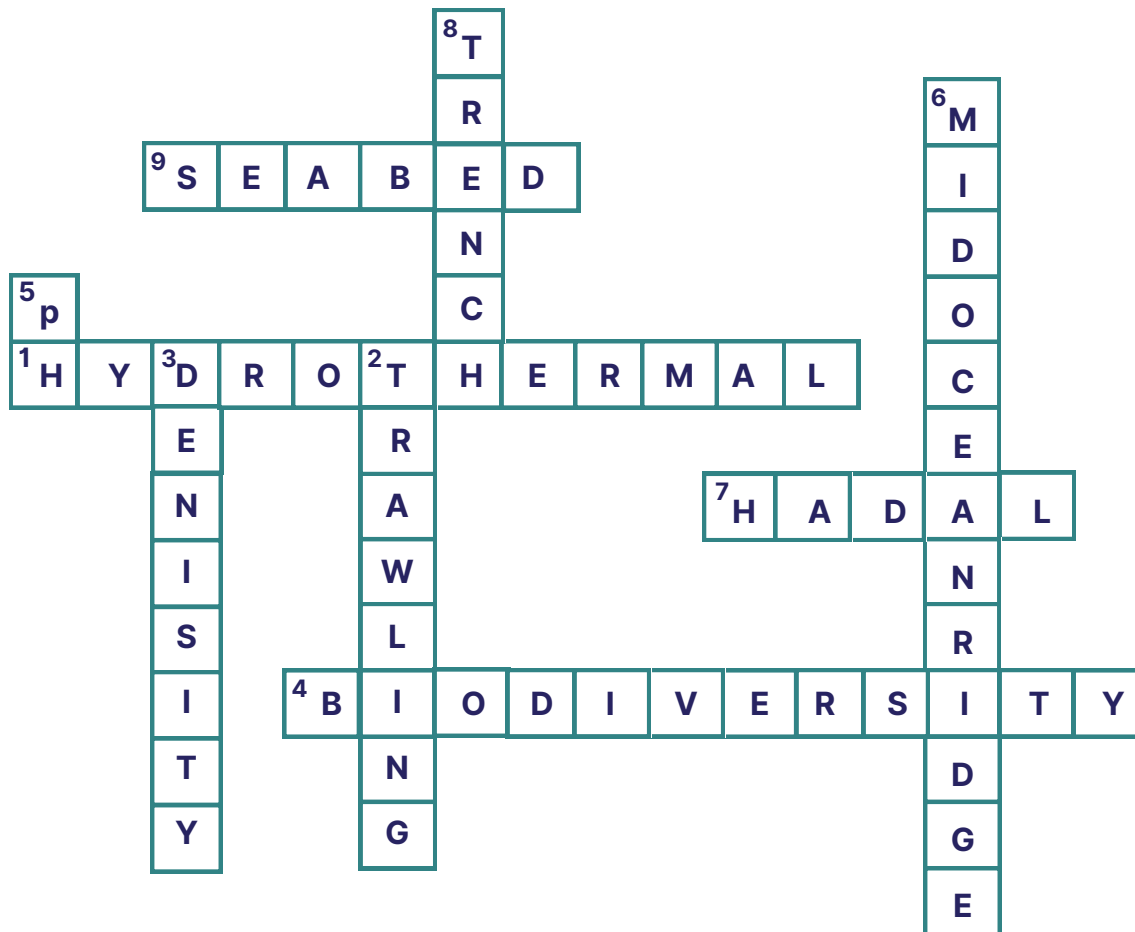
- 1. Hot, underwater spring on the ocean floor.
- 4. Variety of life on Earth.
- 7. The deepest part of this zone. It includes high pressure, near-freezing temperatures, and total darkness.
- 9. The bottom of the ocean.

Down:

- 2. Fishing method that involves dragging large nets along the ocean floor to catch marine species.
- 3. Refers to the mass per unit volume of seawater.
- 5. Measures how acidic or basic a solution is, with 7 being neutral.
- 6. Long, underwater mountain where new seafloor is made by volcanic activity.
- 8. Geologic formations that are the deepest parts of the ocean.



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
